Requests for Marriage Certificates

What to do

Request for Marriage Certificates can be made to the Registrar General via the High Commission on the attached application form. Applicants can only be made by persons aged 16 years and over

1. Completed Section A - details of the couple and
Completed Section B - details of the applicant
2. The form must be certified by a Justice of the Peace, Notary Public, Magistrate, Lawyer, Solicitor, Marriage Officer, Member of Parliament or Senior Police Officer.
3. The person who certifies the application should also endorse two (2) recent passport sized photograph with the words: "I certify that this is a true photograph of the Applicant (Mr/Mrs/Miss)....." and add his/her signature.
4. The applicant should then submit the completed application and endorsed photographs to the High Commission for Saint Vincent with:
 - a. Photographic proof of ID (current passport / Vincentian ID / Photographic Driving Licence / Armed Forces ID)
 - b. Proof of address (Bank Statement / Utility Bill)
 - c. The payment of £11 made be made by Credit/Debit card.

Please indicate if you required the marriage certificate to be legalized/apostilled by the Registry
